

External Medication Source Release of Information

One of the most important roles I serve is to coordinate patient prescriptions. This ensures there are not duplications as well as to monitor for drug interactions and adverse reactions due to the unique medical condition each patient has.

The majority of pharmacies in the United States participate in a clearing house which provides an electronic record of all of the prescriptions a patient is receiving, not just those prescribed by me.

Reviewing the “entire” medication list is extremely helpful and can prevent duplications and be of great use in coordinating a patient’s care.

Since your prescription record is confidential, we must obtain written permission to obtain this information. By signing this consent form you give my office staff permission to obtain all of your medication records from the clearing house and place that in your file.
